I have replaced coolant temp sensor and dizzy cap and leads and lamda but still no joy.any ideas did the fuel pressure regulator give trouble on these or anything like that? I'm at my wits end every time I think it sorted I come back the following day to hear it pop out exhaust and run like crap with a smell of petrol off it.

No idea, but check for errors codes using the diagnostics port in the engine bay.

You need to bridge terminals TE1 and E1 with a wire, then look at the check engine light on the dash, it will flash in a sequence which gives you any error codes stored in the ECU 3 flashes then a pause followed by 2 flashes means an error code of 32 (Air Flow Meter)
