Mechanicals can be sorted easily enough but bodywork and paint can be very expensive if you want it done correctly. If it was me looking at a car like this I wouldn't even drive it if I wasn't happy with the bodywork. But if the car has been stored inside the chances are the body and paint may be ok.
