i can only think of a french guy who said that he did not recieve his parts even though i had confirmation of delivery. that was nearly a year ago now.

the items were sent during a postal strike, and 2 times i had to go to the sorting office to pick the parcel up and re-send them. on the 3rd attempt, i payed extra for insured, recorded delivery which was double what he payed and tracking was confirmed. i did not hear back from him until i had well and truly thrown the tracking details. (something which i wont be doing again) i offered to go to a local scrap yard and buy the parts that i was supposed to send to him and he said that he didnt want that. he wanted all his money back.. that was the end of communication, until he piped up on a thread where i was breaking another car. and i was banned without even being able to reply.

i had quite a good feedback score on imoc, plus all parts i didnt sell through the "for sale" section. i have been an mr2 owner for 7 years and never had a problem until him.

i havent and never had a reason not to send him his parts. and i still to this day have the parts i bought

from the scrap yard that he decided he didnt want. if he genuinely did not recieve his parts, i would have refunded him straight away and maybe send him the replacement parts i bought. but some people really just want things for free.

selling used parts is quite a dodgy market if i am honest. if i didnt love the mr2's and the community i definately wouldnt be doing this today. i get a buzz out of people being happy about the parts i have sold them.
